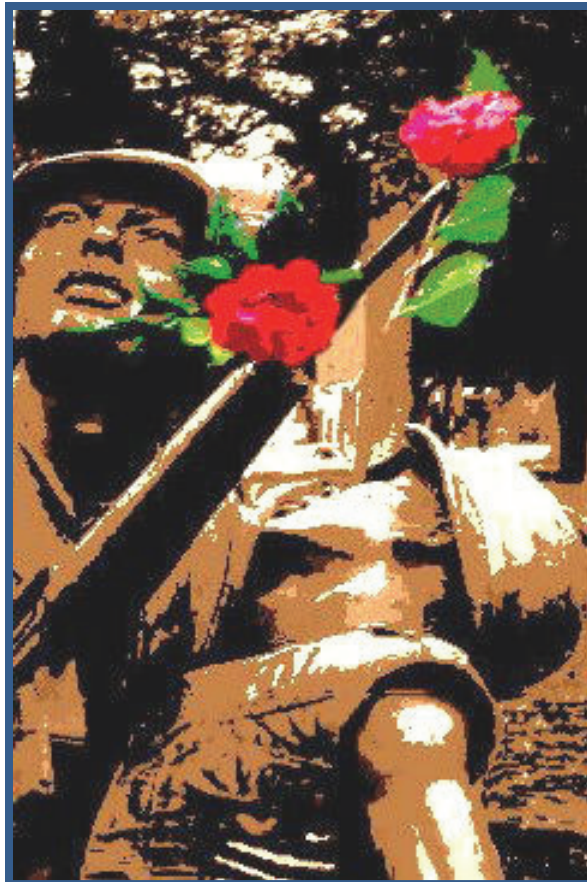


Join us for
